Model Vehicle Catalogue software is safe to download and install as long as it is downloaded from www.modelvehiclecatalogue.com.

Windows 7/8 Warning

When downloading Model Vehicle Catalogue software some browsers issue warnings when software packages are unknown to them.

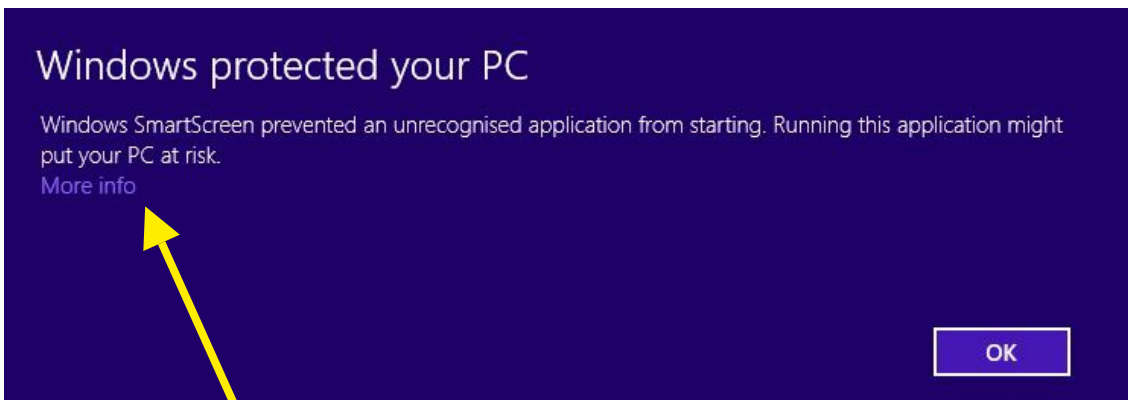
Typically the following warning can be given:



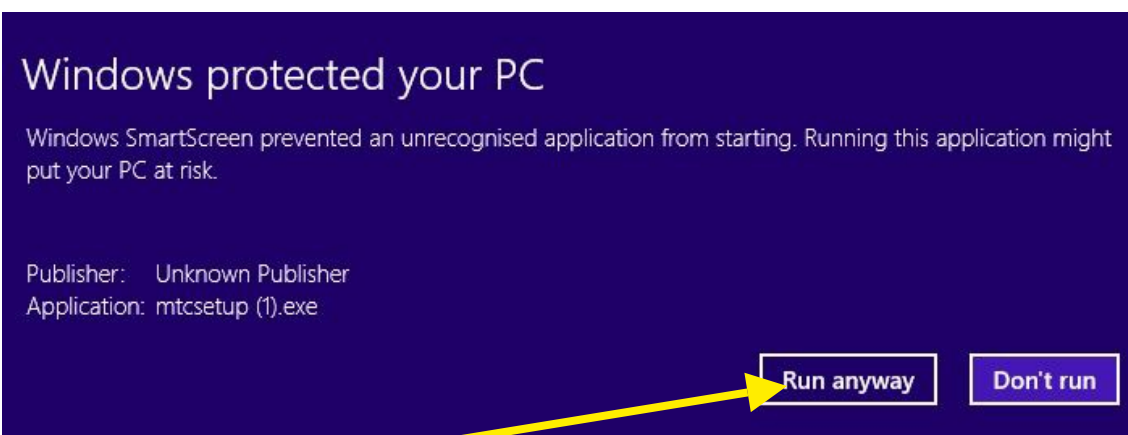
Either Click on the 'X' or use the 'View downloads' button to install the software

Click on 'More Info' and this appears.....

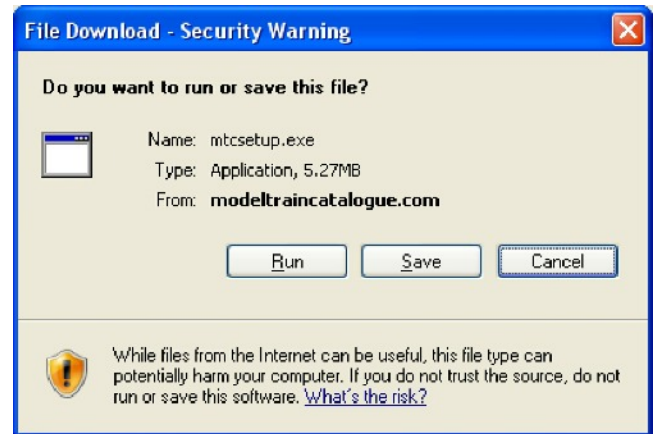


Click on 'Run anyway'

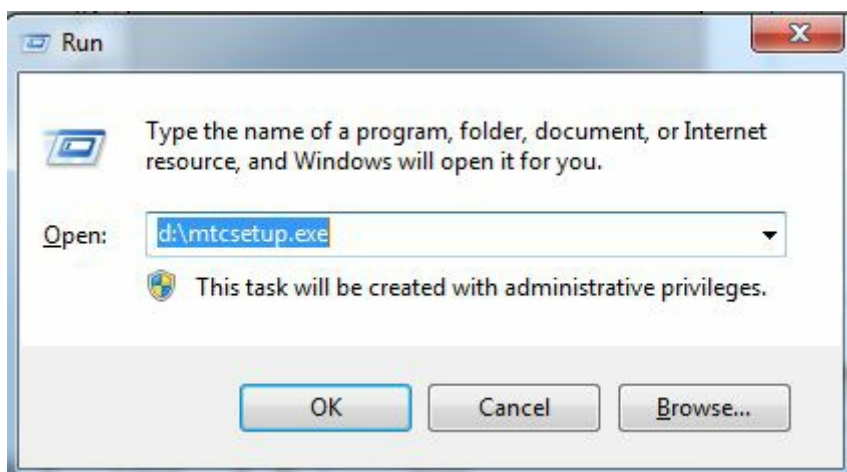
Mcafee SiteAdvisor Warning

Typically the following warning can be given:

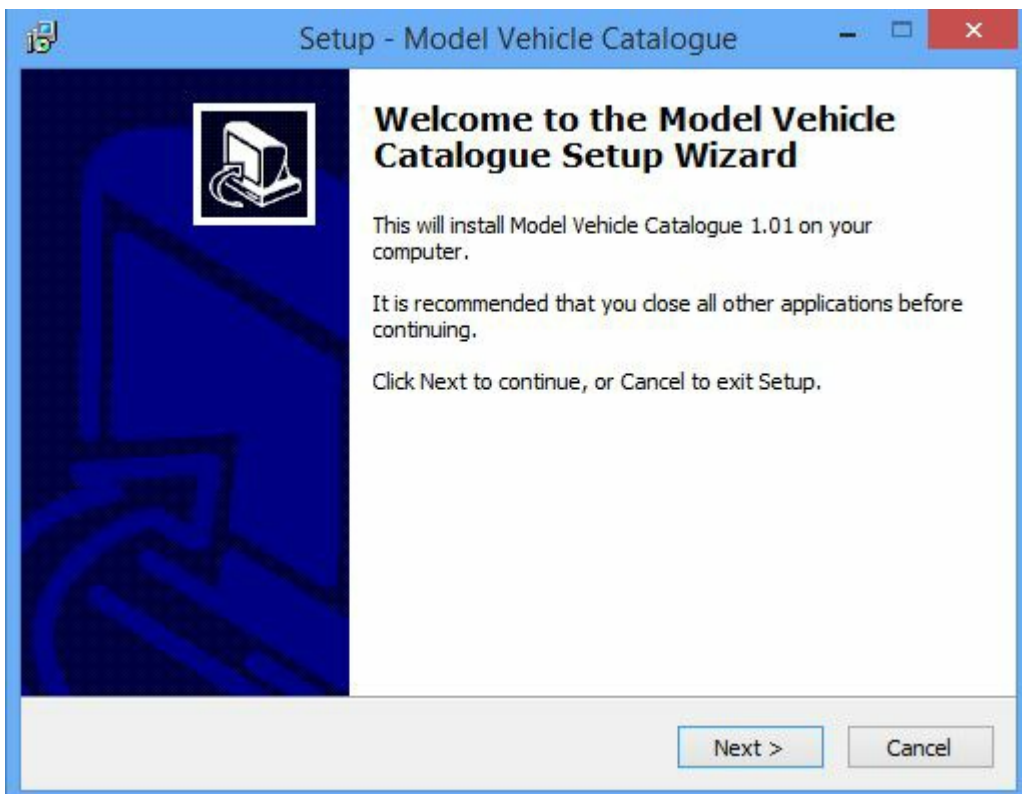


Press the Windows Key and 'R' together to bring up the RUN box.

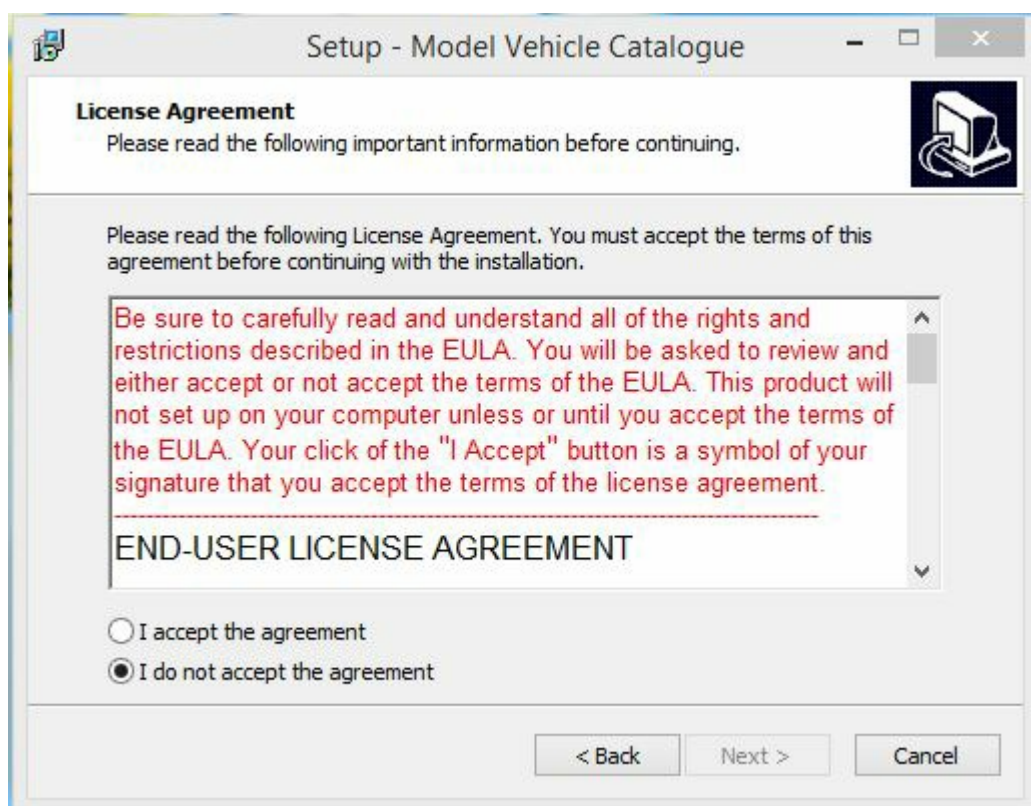


Either Browse to location of mvcsetup.exe (usually the download folder) or type it in if the location is known in full.

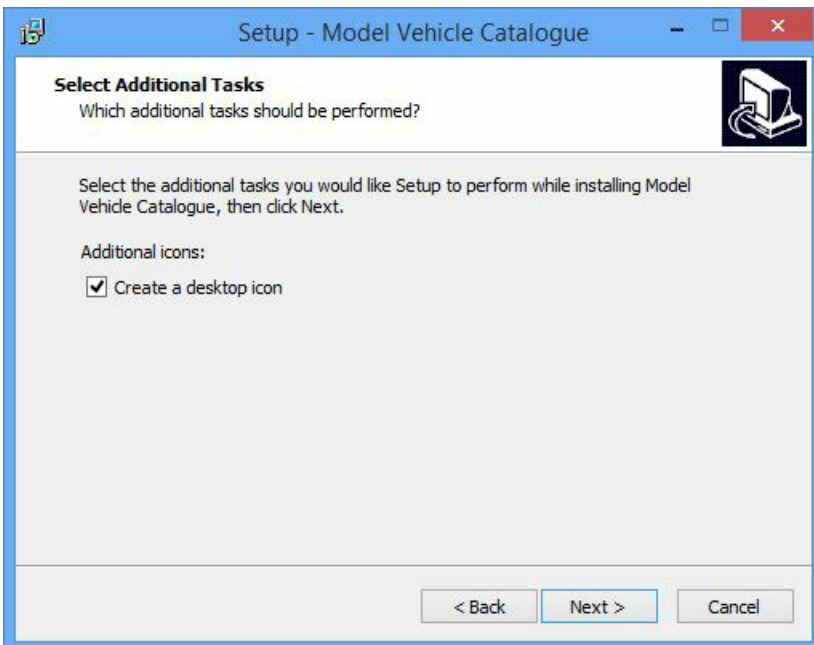
Then Click the 'OK' Button.



Click the 'Next' button.

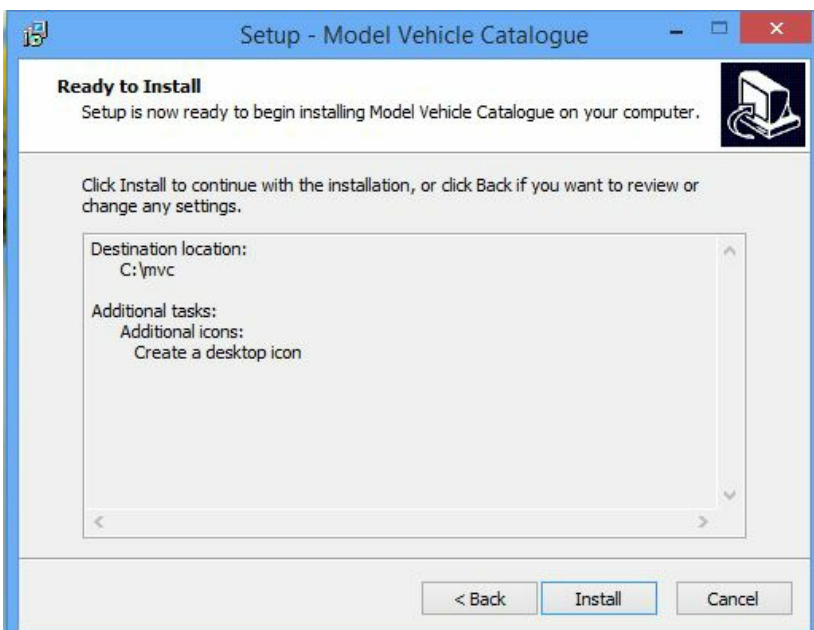


If the End User Licence Agreement is acceptable, Click Acceptance and then Click the 'Next' button.

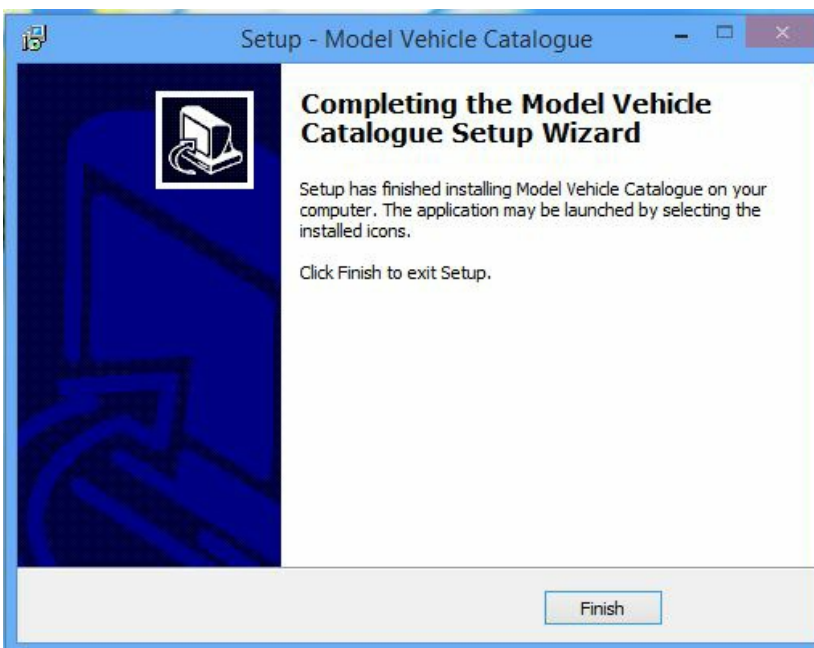


Only if a Desktop Startup Icon is NOT required untick the 'Create a Desktop Icon' box.

Norton Anti-Virus

Although MVC.EXE is white listed by Symantec, some Norton Anti-Virus products can be over zealous and remove mvc.exe from the PC thinking that it is a dangerous file.

If this has happened, follow these instructions:

1. Open your Norton product
2. On the main window click Tasks and there on the Security History option
3. On the opened window click on the drop down menu and select Quarantine
4. On the list find mvc.exe
5. Click on More Details (bottom, right side)
6. On the new window click on Options (bottom)
7. Click on Restore file
8. Check the "do not detect it any more option" during the restore
9. Close windows
